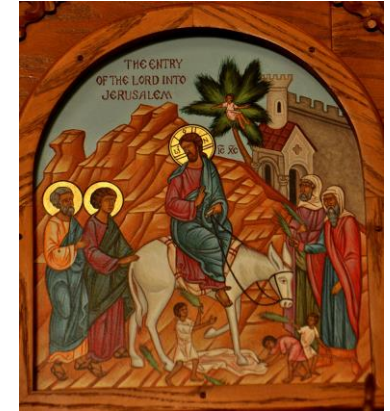

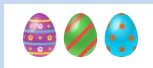
Collection in aid of Action for Children North Yorkshire Young Carers Harrogate and Craven (this year's Circuit Mission project)
